- 6) If you have an 8 AM exam and you miss lunch, you will have time to eat after. If you have a 12:00 PM exam, please eat lunch during 4th period.
- 7) Do NOT bring any food or drink (including water) into the testing room.
- 8) If you finish your exam early, you CANNOT leave the testing room. All students MUST stay until official time is called, ALL materials are collected, and the exam proctor officially dismisses you.
